First Holy Communion Mass - Saturday May 3rd 2025

9:30 AM - Please have children arrive by 9:00 AM at the School Building.

The Church will be open from 8:00 am on - Mass is approximately one hour.

Weather permitting students will come to the school building and we will walk over to the church together. Students will process in and sit together. In case of rain students will come to the church directly. If that is the case, I'll send an e-mail the morning of. There will be seats reserved for parents and very young children that can sit on parent's laps. Seating for all others will be open seating, anywhere except the reserved parent's seats. Each student will be able to have up to 6 total guests. That is parents and 4 additional. Tickets will not be issued. The mass will be live streamed. Following mass and pictures First Eucharist Certificates will be distributed in the Cry Room.

Pictures:

Out of reverence for the mass, walking around the church to take pictures during the liturgy will not be allowed. Pictures may only be taken from your seat during mass. At the conclusion families will be able to take pictures on the altar as well as outside. Please show reverence during pictures on the altar.

Dress Code:

Girls: White dress (no hoops, or crinoline please), white veil, white socks (anklets, knee socks or stockings), white dress shoes. No gloves, please.

Boys: Navy blue, black or white suit, white shirt, white tie, dress shoes.

Children are not to wear or carry flowers during the Mass please.

First Eucharist Practice:

There will be one practice for students on Tuesday April 29th from 5:30 to 6:45 pm in the church. We ask children to be dropped off and picked up after practice. It will be for 1 hour and 15 minutes. We will practice the procession, how to receive Communion, and other important aspects of the Mass, prayers, and responses as well as the music.

Family Day:

In preparation for First Eucharist, we will have Family Day on Saturday March 29th 2025 from 9:30 am to 1:00 pm in the school building.

It will be for students and at least one parent. I ask only 2nd grade children, please. We'll have bagels, coffee, tea, juice, water, games, stories, and crafts.

<u>First Penance – April 2025 Exact Dates to be Determined.</u> <u>It will be Multiple Weekday evenings.</u>

Children will be seated by their class. Signs will be posted on the pews. Children will go directly to their seats when they arrive. Parents may be seated in the rows behind or near the classes.

Please leave a few extra empty pews between parents and children.

The Prayer service, which will last approximately 40 minutes, consists of:

Opening Prayer, Reading from Scripture, Homily, Examination of Conscience, Act
of Contrition, Confession, Penance.

PICTURE OR VIDEO TAPING IS NOT ALLOWED TO PROTECT THE SEAL OF CONFESSION. PARENTS, PLEASE REMAIN AT YOUR SEATS DURING THE SERVICE.

FIRST RECONCILIATION is face-to-face. Confessionals will not be used.

While seated and waiting for the service to begin, children should sit silently and reflect on some of the ways in which they may have separated themselves from God's love:

- Have we not told the truth?
- Have we been hurtful to others?
- Do we obey our parents, and grown-ups in our lives?
- Have we taken anything that does not belong to us?

Children should know the *Act of Contrition;* however, they will read it together as a group before approaching the priest.

When they approach the priest, they sit down, pray the Sign of the Cross, and say:

"Bless me Father for I have sinned; this is my First Confession."

Father will talk to them and give them their penance – children should know their prayers

(The Our Father, Hail Mary and The Glory Be). The priest will give them absolution.

Children will return to their seats, kneel, and pray the prayers given to them by the priest. When they have finished praying, they will leave the church **quietly** as other children are celebrating the Sacrament.








The Body of Christ
