- 6. What does it mean to believe? To accept as true, even though we can't understand it.
- 7. What is the greatest act of worship in the Church? The Celebration of Mass.

- 24. What was Mary's response when the angel Gabriel appeared to her? "Let it be done to me. According to your word."
- 25. What is Advent? 4 weeks of expectant waiting and preparation for the celebration of the Nativity of Jesus at Christmas.
- 26. Why was Jesus born in a stable? Mary & Joseph found no room, so they stayed in the stable.
- 27. When and where was Jesus born? December 25th in Bethlehem, Israel

28. Was Dec. 25 the actual date of his birth? In his book, The Spirit of the Liturgy, Pope Benedict comments: "The claim used to be made that December 25 developed in opposition to the Mithras myth, or as a Christian response to the cult of the unconquered sun promoted by Roman emperors in the third century in their efforts to establish a new imperial religion. However, these old theories can no longer be sustained" (pp., 107-108).

- 32. Which Apostle betrayed Jesus? Judas
- 33. Who was Pontius Pilate? The Roman governor of Israel who had Jesus put to death
- 34. What crime was Jesus accused of? Inciting the Jews against Ceasar and being King of the Jews
- 35. What are the three days during Holy Week? **The Triduum Holy Thursday , Good Friday, Holy Saturday**
- 36. What happened on Holy Thursday? Last Supper

- 71. What are the Beatitudes? A set of 8 teachings/blessings by Jesus that appear in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. (the Sermon on the Mount)
- 72. What is a canonized saint? A saint that has a day set aside in the liturgical calendar in his/her honor.

73. What does "real presence" mean? Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist at consecration when the bread and wine are transformed into body and blood

74. What are the four marks of the Church? one, holy, Catholic and apostolic

75. What is chrism? Oil used for anointing at Confirmation that signifies grace and service to God.

76. What is the "Laying on of Hands?" – Gesture of holding one's hands on or over things/people to transmit power, duty or blessing.
